

December 6th. 1933.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, December 6th. 1933 at 10.30 p.m.

Present: Commissioner Mahony and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of November 29th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Secretary, Union of B.C. Municipalities - advising that the annual convention has been arranged for January 29th. 1934 at the City of Victoria and requesting that any resolutions for submission to be convention be placed in the hands of the Solicitor, Mr. G. E. Martin, not later than January 15th.
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

2 H. Ambrosch - requesting that logs and stumps lying along the south part of road on north of his property (No. Lot 5, D.L. 131.) be removed. The Acting Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted report advising that the stumps in question had apparently been deposited by Municipality at time of opening portion of the street (Halifax St) and that the estimated cost of removing same was approximately \$80.00
