

Wednesday - June 27th, 1934.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, June 27th, 1934 at 10.10 a.m.  
Present: Commissioner Fraser; Mr. R. Bolton and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of June 21st inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Broadview Ratepayers Association - suggesting that the Commissioner take up the question of Tax sales with the Provincial authorities.  
Messrs Turley and Nicholson attended and addressed the Commissioner suggesting that the Provincial Government be requested to arrange for a (1) Moratorium on Tax sales (?) Consolidation of taxes and (3) abolition of Penalties.  
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and the matter be tabled for consideration."

Secretary, North Burnaby Horticultural Association and Secretary South Burnaby Farmers Institute advising that it was not their intention to stage an agricultural exhibit at the Canada Pacific Exhibition but protesting against the use of their Association's name by any other party.  
Ordered: "That the letters be received and filed."

Ordered: "That the application of F. Hall be received and filed and the applicant be advised that the Commissioner cannot see his way to granting him the use of the name of "Burnaby" in connection with the staging of the proposed agricultural exhibit."

Journeyman Barbers International Union - forwarding petition praying for the passing of a by-law under the "Shops Closing Act".  
Ordered: "That the petition be referred to the Clerk for certificate of sufficiency."

Ordered: "That the Requisitions as submitted be approved."


Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No.3,1934."
