A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 4th.1934 at 10.00 a.m.  
Present: Commissioner E.W.Fraser, Municipal Treasurer, R.Bolton and the Municipal Clerk, C.P.Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of March 28th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

The Municipal Clerk reported that Norman H. Hawkins, Municipal Engineer had passed away at his residence on Friday, March 30th.1934.

Ordered: "That the report be received and that this Corporation convey to Mrs.Hawkins and family a vote of condolence and sympathy.
