

Wednesday - December 5th, 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, December 5th, 1934 at 80.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner H. W. Fraser; Mr. F. Polton; Mr. E. P. Scott; Mr. W. P. Philips; Dr. Wm. Sager; Mr. A. C. Pell, Mr. F. J. Russell and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of November 28th. ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

J.S. Cowper - again drawing attention to nuisance arising from the operation of the Pump at Capitol Hill and requesting that provision be made in the 1935 estimates to eliminate this nuisance.

Ordered: "That the letter be referred to the Works Superintendent for report."

R.F. Orr - suggesting that the time was now opportune to bring down legislation creating a building line on Kingsway.

Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Works Superintendent and the Clerk for report and recommendation."

Triumph Chapter, O.E.S. calling attention to lighting conditions at corner of MacDonald Avenue and Triumph Street.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and the writers be advised that the matter of installation of a street light at this intersection has been given consideration but that the financial position renders it impossible at this time, and further that the owners of the building at this corner be advised that a light on the building would materially assist the users of the building."

The Chief Constable submitted reports on fires as follows:

Ordered: "That the reports be received and filed."

The Works Superintendent submitted recommendation that B.C.E.R. pole plans be approved as follows:

1. K.8800/1794 Proposed pole line on Clare Avenue, north of Hastings Street, Distance from property line to face of poles to be 10'6".
K.8800/1795 Proposed pole line on Somers Street, West of Sperling Avenue, Distance from property line to face of poles to be 10'6".

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Works Superintendent be and is hereby adopted."

The Clerk submitted report on matter of water supply to the Dominion Bridge Coy. advising that the main had given trouble since date of installation, February 1930. and that the main had been shut off on April 13th, 1934. The report also showed figures as to cost of construction, renovation and maintenance.

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed and that the Works Superintendent bring down detailed report showing particulars of proposals to renovate this line."

2. The Building Inspector and Assistant Fire Marshal submitted report on matter of building situate on North half of Lot 7, S.D. 35/36, D.L. 158 advising that the Fire Marshal had modified his order to the effect that the building might be boarded up to prevent access by unauthorized persons.

Ordered: "That the report be received and the Building Inspector be authorised to have the building properly boarded up."

Ordered: "That the Works Superintendent and the Clerk be instructed to take up matter of commercial crossing Regent Garage Hastings St. with the Imperial Oil Ltd."

The sitting then adjourned at 11.06 a.m.
