

Wednesday - June 6th, 1934

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, June 6th inst. at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser; Mr. R Bolton, Treasurer and the Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sittings of May 30th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Royal Trust Coy. requesting permit to erect a garage on Lot 4, Block 1, D.L. 79.S. at a lessor distance from the front property line than called for in the Burnaby Town Planning By-law.

The Building Inspector submitted report advising that in his opinion no good reason existed why the garage in question should not be built in its proper location.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Building Inspector be approved."

The Chief Constable submitted reports on fires as follows:

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Druggists Agreement Authorization By-law 1934 be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Druggists Agreement Authorization By-law 1934 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider Burnaby Medical Aid Agreement Authorization By-law 1934."

Ordered: "That the committee do now rise and report the by-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That the "Burnaby Medical Aid Agreement Authorization By-law 1934" be now read a third time."

Ordered: "That the "Burnaby Medical Aid Agreement Authorization By-law 1934" do pass the Third reading, tht it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

General accounts to May 31st, 1934, amounting to \$6,662.53; Relief accounts \$41,257.47; Pay Rolls \$3,595.17 and Salaries account \$6,542.90 were examined.

Ordered: "That General accounts, Relief accounts, Pay rolls, and Salaries be approved for payment when properly certified."

The sitting then adjourned at 90.30 a.m.
