

Wednesday - March 6th. 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, March 6th. 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Hugh M Fraser, Mr. R. Bolton, Treasurer and the Municipal Clerk.
Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of February 28th ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. North Burnaby Board of Trade - forwarding copy of resolution forwarded by the Board to the Provincial Government requesting that steps be taken to establish some form of Public works in Burnaby to provide employment, and requesting that the resolution be endorsed and the Government be so informed.
Ordered: "That the letter and resolution be received and the Board be advised that the Commissioner has already approached the Government with a view to obtaining some kind of works programme."

2. North Burnaby Board of Trade - resubmitting resolution passed by the Board at its meeting on January 23rd last, calling upon the Commissioner to give nine months notice to the B.C.E.R. to permanent track the Hastings Street east extension line.
Ordered: "That this letter be received and be tabled for consideration."

3. E. Bloomfield - requesting permission to use Lot 13, SD 2, Blocks 2 & 3, T.L. 25.E.
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and the applicant be advised that the future policy in connection with granting use of Corporation lots calls for rental ~~of~~ in the sum equal to the annual taxes."

K. The Treasurer submitted recommendation that Tax sale certificate covering Lot 37, D.L. 85. (12 and 12.16 acre portion) be sold to R. H. Hobbs, 3631 Claude Avenue, Burnaby for sum of \$73.65
Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be adopted."

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Engineer and Treasurer be adopted."
