

Tuesday - October 1st, 1935.

A sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday, October 1st, 1935 at 1.45 p.m.

The Treasurer submitted a recommendation that offers to sell Corporation of Burnaby debentures be accepted as follows:

Ordered: "That this matter be tabled pending report as to the Assessed value, area, etc."
