

Wednesday, April 17th, 1935.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 17th, 1935 at 10.00 o'clock p.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser, E. Belton, F. J. Rundel, A.F. McFee, Dr. Sager, A. C. Bell, P.E. Scott, and C.E. Brown, Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of April 10th, instant be adopted as read, and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

South Burnaby Horticultural Society wrote requesting a grant sufficient to cover amount of hall rent for a fall fair and flower show to be held at the Jubilee United Church Hall.

Ordered: "That this letter be laid over for consideration and that the amount of rent be obtained."

Crehan, Mount & Co. wrote suggesting that sundry debtors should be circularized at an early date.

Ordered: "That this matter be left in the hands of the Treasurer to take up with the auditors as to cost, and report next week."

A. MacLellan et al petitioning for improved water service to residents and householders on Willard Avenue, 14th. Ave., 12th. Ave. 10th. Ave. south of Marine Drive.

Ordered: "That this petition be referred to the Superintendent of Work for report."

B. P. Scott, Superintendent, submitted report recommending that B.C.E. Fly Pole plan No. K8800/1818 be approved as follows:

K8800/1818 Proposed pole location in lane south of Venables Street west of Madison Avenue. Distance from property line to face of poles to be 1' 0".

It was further decided that Fire Prevention Officers for the purpose of bush fire fighting be appointed as follows: Arthur Hall, E.J. Renwick, G. Estridge, and R. Stevens.
