

Wednesday - April 3rd. 1935.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 3rd. 1935 at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser, R. Bolton, F.J. Russell, Dr. Wm. Sager, A. P. McPee, A. C. Bell, P. B. Scott, and C. B. Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of March 27th. ultimo be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

The Secretary-Treasurer, Union of British Columbia Municipalities wrote re Municipal Superannuation.

Ordered: "That the Clerk and Treasurer be appointed a Committee to represent this Corporation at a meeting to be held at the City Hall, Vancouver, B.C. on Saturday, April 13th. 1935 and at 8 p.m."

J. W. MacDonald wrote claiming \$8.00 for loss of poultry.

Ordered: "That this claim be referred to a Committee of the Clerk and Treasurer."

The B. C. Canine Protective Assn. wrote offering their services when claims for destruction of poultry by dogs were being considered.

Ordered: "That this letter be received; and that the Clerk acknowledge same."

S. J. Bush et al wrote complaining of condition of Gilley Avenue between the two car tracks.

P. B. Scott, Superintendent of Works submitted report recommending "That portion of Gilley Avenue between Highland Park Line and Central Park Line, B.C.E. Ry. be scarified, oil mulched, graded, rolled and flushcoated at an estimated cost of \$175.00."

Ordered: "That the petition from Bush et.al be received, and that the recommendation of the Superintendent of Works be adopted."

The Garagemen's Assn. of B. C. wrote enclosing questionnaire and requesting that a representative be appointed to attend a mass meeting of the Retail Petroleum Product Vendors.

Ordered: "That this letter be received and information requested be supplied. No representative was appointed to attend the meeting."

North Burnaby Liberal Assn. wrote requesting that Willingdon Avenue connecting North and South Burnaby be put in good condition.

Ordered: "That everything possible will be done, and that the Liberal Assn. be so advised."

Ordered: "That the Estimates as submitted be approved subject to funds being available."

Building Inspector submitted report on application of Mrs. Sellers, of 3409 Barker Avenue to have fence renewed at a cost of \$11.00, fifty per cent of which cost is to be paid by Mrs. Baker residing on the property immediately north.

Ordered: "That the report be received and that the work be proceeded with."

The Assessor and Property Salesman submitted report on application of E. F. Tyler to rent part of Blk. 20, D.L. 97, adjoining his own property, for which he offers the sum of \$25.00 per year, and recommended that the application be approved. The Treasurer recommended the adoption of ~~af~~ this report."

Ordered: "That General accounts to March 31st, 1935 amounting to \$10,611.42, Relief Accounts \$37,853.74, Pay Rolls \$2029.82 and Salaries \$4107.00 be approved for payment."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Unemployment Relief Loan By-law be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Unemployment Relief Loan By-law do pass the third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The sitting then adjourned.
