

Wednesday, July 3rd, 1935.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, on Wednesday July 3rd, 1935, at 10.00 o'clock a.m.
Present: Commissioner H. M. Fraser, R. Bolton, A. C. Bell, B. P. Scott, Dr. Sager
E. B. Brown, W.P. Philips, F. J. Rundell.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of June 26th. be adopted as written."

Correspondence was received as follows:

1. Mrs. R. Bancroft wrote making claim in the sum of \$10.00 for hens killed by stray dogs.
Ordered: "That this claim be laid over pending report which will be submitted on the whole situation."
2. Vancouver Harbour Commissioners wrote re complaint received at this office in the matter of dumping of oil by the Shell Oil Co. plant at Burrard Inlet, and advised that after investigation they are satisfied that as the utmost of care is taken in filtration, it is only by accident that any oil escapes.
Ordered: "That this communication be received and filed."
3. B. P. Scott, Superintendent, wrote re water supply on Silver Avenue B. C. E.R. right-of-way to Kingsway, advising that the 2" main on this street be opened up and cleaned where required, with the installation of an additional connection to the 10" main on Kingsway at an estimated cost of \$37.50
Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Superintendent be adopted."
4. Mr. Wm. McCurragh - 14th. Avenue, attended and addressed the Commissioner regarding the condition of the Sidewalk on 14th. Avenue.
Ordered: "That the Superintendent be requested to submit report."
