

Wednesday, May 8th. 1935.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, May 8th. 1935 at 10 o'clock a.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser, B. P. Scott, W. P. Philips, R. Bolton, C. B. Brown and F. J. Russell.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of May 8th. be adopted as written and confirmed."

R. G. Rae wrote requesting that the level of Deer lake be lowered and creek running through his property cleaned out to prevent the recurrent flooding of lands.
Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Engineer for report."

Chief Engineer, Department of Public Works, Victoria wrote advising that he had gone fully into the matter of Bulkheads on Kingsway and that as there is no change in the condition of the bulkheads, there is no alteration can be made in the decision of the Department.
