

Wednesday - April 15th. 1936.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 15th. 1936 at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Commissioner H.M.Fraser;

Messrs R.Polton, C.B.Brown; E.L.Rimmer; A.McFee; Dr.Wm.Sager; F.J.Russell and A.C.Bell.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of April 8th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Secretary, Broadview Ratepayers Association - calling attention to recent fire which occurred in the Ardley district and the lack of fire protection afforded this district, and suggesting that consideration be given to providing a quantity of hose and a hand hose reel. Ordered: "That the letter be received and that Messrs F.J.Russell; A.C.Bell and R.Bolton be appointed a committee to investigate conditions and to make recommendation."

Secretary, Broadview Ratepayers Association - expressing appreciation for the assistance given their delegation in matter of obtaining mail delivery extension.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

Ordered: "That Mr.F.J.Russell be delegated to attend as representative of this district."
