Local Board of Health - December 2nd, 1936.

The Commissioner sat as a Local Board of Health on Wednesday, December 2nd, 1936 at 11.15 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser; Messrs R. Bolton, A.C. Bell, C.B. Brown and Dr. Sager.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of the Commissioner as a Local Board of Health on be adopted as written and confirmed."

The Medical Health Officer submitted report of an inspection carried out by himself and the Sanitary Inspector at Ballard's Abattoir on Eyrne Road, and advised that conditions were such that he recommended the license granted to Dr. Ballard be revoked. The Commissioner submitted a copy of a letter he had received written by one Gerrard to Mr. Jack Price, M.L.A. complaining of the condition of the abattoir dated, June 30th, 1936.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Medical Health Officer that the license to operate an Abattoir on part of Block 3, D.L. 166A. issued to Dr. W.G. Ballard on August 9th, 1934 be revoked, be and is hereby adopted."

Ordered: "That the letter from Mr. Gerrard to Mr. Jack Price, M.L.A. be received and filed and that Mr. Price be invited to inspect the premises."
