

Wednesday - April 22nd. 1936.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, April 22nd. 1936 at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser
Messrs F.J.Russell; Dr.Wm.Sager; E.L.Fimmer; W.P.Philps; A.C.Bell;
J.G.Mill and R.Bolton, and the Municipal Clerk,C.E.Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of April 15th inst. be adapted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Secretary, North Burnaby Auxiliary to the V.O.N. requesting permission to hold a Tag Day on May 16th in North Burnaby.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and permission as requested be granted."

Property Committee Report:

Your committee met on April 21st,1936 and recommend:

1. That Lot 15, Block 11, D.L.99 be sold to N.H.Firth for sum of \$200.00
2. That Lot 10, Block 28, D.L.117W₂ be sold to G.F.Whiting for sum of \$75.00

Ordered: "That the report of the Property Committee be adopted."

Ordered: "That General accounts to April 18th,1936 \$11,584.37; Relief accounts \$34,721.19 and Payrolls \$2,429.53 be approved for payment."

The Requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That the Requisitions as submitted be approved."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No.4,1936"

Ordered: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Land Sale By-law No.4,1936 be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Land Sale By-law No.4,1936 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The Rev. Mr.Graham and Mr.Morrison, of the Vancouver Heights United Church attended and addressed the Commissioner with reference to application of the Vancouver Heights Young People's Association's for lease of Lots 1 and 2, Block 14, D.L. 186 for purpose of using same as a Tennis Court.

The Assessor advised that the amount of annual taxes on this property would, if levied, amount to approximately \$70.00 per annum.

Ordered: "That Messrs Graham and Morrison be advised to suggest to the Young Peoples Association that they re-submit their application giving the fullest information as to the amount they can afford to pay for the use of this property."

The Sitting then adjourned.
