Ordered: "That the Estimates as submitted be approved, subject to funds being available."

Board of Works Committee Report:

1. That W. H. Doherty be given permission to have B. C. Telephone Co. wires strung across Lot 23, Blk. 37, D.L. 188.
2. That Municipal Electrician be instructed to have standard No. 9, repaired at an estimated cost of \$30.00, and that statement of cost be submitted to the Treasurer for collection.

Ordered: "That the report of the Board of Works Committee be adopted."

Property Committee Report:

1. That Lots 1 to 4, Sd. 2, Blk. 16, D.L. 79 be rented to F. Cummings for the balance of the year for pasture purposes for \$5.00
2. That West half of Lot 28, and 29, Blk. 19, D.L. 74N $\frac{1}{2}$ be sold to Clare B. Bowden for the sum of \$162.62.

Ordered: "That the report of the Property Committee be adopted."

The Requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That the requisitions as submitted, be approved."

The meeting then adjourned.
