

Wednesday, February 26th, 1936.

A Sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, on Wednesday, February 26th, 1936, at 10 o'clock a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser, F. J. Russell, W. P. Philips, Dr. Sager, K. C. Bell, J. G. Mill, E. L. Rimmer, C. B. Brown and R. Bolton.

Ordered: "That the Minutes of the meeting of February 19th, 1936, be adopted as written and confirmed."

1. The Assessor submitted the 1936 Assessment figures as confirmed by the Court of Revision, as follows:-

2. The Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board submitted precept for the year 1936 showing the District of Burnaby's portion to be \$37,798.21.
Ordered: "That this Precept be received and filed and referred to Estimates."

The Property Committee submitted report as follows:

Your Committee met on February 25th, 1936 and recommends:

3. 1. That Block 62, D.L. 83 be sold to H. D. Esplin (original owner) for the sum of \$240.00 cash.

Your Committee met on February 21st, 1936 and recommends:

4. 1. That repairs be carried out at an approximate cost of \$25.00 to Building on Lot 2, Blk. 15, B.L. 97.
6. 2. That building on Block 27, D.L. 151/3 be demolished and the salvaged material be placed at the disposal of the Engineer.

Ordered: "That the report of the Property Committee be adopted."

The Commissioner will now sit as a Committee to re-consider "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 2, 1936."

The Committee will now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment.

The "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 2, 1936" will now be read a Third time.

Ordered: "That the "Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 2, 1936" do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk, and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The Commissioner will now sit as a Committee to re-consider "Burnaby Sale of Gasoline Regulation By-law 1936".

The Committee will now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment.

The "Burnaby Sale of Gasoline Regulation By-law 1936" will now be read a Third time.

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Sale of Gasoline Regulation By-law 1936 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk, and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."


Requisitions as submitted were then examined.
