Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a Committee of the whole to re-consider Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 9, 1936."

Ordered: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 9, 1936 be now read a third time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Land Sale By-law No. 9, 1936 do pass the third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No. 3, 1936 be introduced and read a first time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No. 3, 1936 do pass the first reading."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No. 3, 1936 be now read a second time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No. 3, 1936 do pass the second reading."
