

July 29th, 1936. (Wednesday)

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Wednesday, July 29th, 1936 at 10 o'clock a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser, R. Bolton, F. J. Russell, W.P. Philps, Wm. Sager, A. C. Bell, J. G. Mill and E.L. Rimmer.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of July 22nd, 1936, be adopted as written, and confirmed."

Minister of Finance wrote advising that the Government of the Province of British Columbia has reduced the rate of interest payable on all Demand notes to $3\frac{1}{2}\%$, effective July 1st, 1936.

Ordered: "That the communication be received and filed."

Secretary, Social Service Councils wrote requesting that property on Kingsway and Marlborough, formerly owned by a Mr. Barber, be reserved as a recreation Park.

Ordered: "That the communication be received and the delegation heard." The delegation consisting of Mrs. A. P. Beaven, Mrs. Callander, Mr. J. H. Young, Mr. Ryan, Mr. A. E. Horsman and Mr. Rutherford addressed the Commissioner requesting the dedication of Block 27, District Lot 152 as a Public Park and recreation ground. The Commissioner promised consideration of the request.
