

Monday - October 5th, 1936.

A sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 5th, 1936 at 4.30 p.m.

Present: Commissioner Hugh M Fraser, R. Bolton, J.G. Mill and C.B. Brown.

The Relief officer submitted recommendations that Relief orders in the amount of \$41.24 and \$16.78 respectively be approved respecting Mrs. Alice Barber and Miss E.L. Dodd in order to protect their respective homes from the 1936 tax sale, as follows: Mrs. B. McLean, Lots 1 & 2, Blk. 58, D.L. 218 \$20.96

Mrs. Alice Barber E $\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 3, Block 19, D.L. 116S $\frac{1}{2}$ - \$41.24
Miss E.L. Dodd, Lot 20, Block 11, D.L. 122. - \$16.78

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Relief Officer be and is hereby adopted"

Messrs Hall, Holland & Co. Limited submitted an offer to purchase \$1,800.00 4% Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines, guaranteed as to principal and interest by the Province of Saskatchewan, due 1939, at 97 and accrued interest. The Treasurer recommended that the offer be accepted.

Ordered: "That the sale of One thousand eight hundred pounds sterling (£1,800) 4% Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines, guaranteed as to principal and interest by the Province of Saskatchewan, due 1939, to Hall Holland and Company Limited of Vancouver, B.C. in accordance with the terms and conditions of letter under date of September 28th, 1936, at 97 and accrued interest be and is hereby approved, and that the Commissioner and the Clerk be and are hereby authorized to sign and affix the Corporate seal to indenture of Transfer."

The sitting then adjourned.
