

Wednesday - September 15th, 1937

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday September 15th, 1937 at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton, W. P. Philips, Dr. Sagar, A.C. Bell, J.G. Mill, E.L. Rimmer and C.B. Brown.
