The Clerk reported that at a meeting held on Friday, April 23rd, inst arrangements had been completed for the holding of an open air Church Service on Sunday, May 9th, at 3 o'clock p.m. at the Kingsway West School grounds, and that Rev. Mr. Peter Henderson, assisted by Rev. Mr. Dingle were making arrangements for the form of service, etc. The Committee further suggested that the Commissioner insert an advertisement in the Local press enjoining all Residents of Burnaby to attend the service.

Ordered: "That the suggestion of the committee be adopted."
