

Friday - December 3rd. 1937.

A sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Friday, December 3rd. 1937 at 10.45 a.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton and C.B. Brown.

Ordered: "That Petition to the Honourable the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council re acceptance of Quit Claim Deed from John Wesley McLeod and praying for authority to enter into an agreement for sale with the said John Wesley McLeod be signed by the Commissioner and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."


The Building Inspector submitted a recommendation that owing to the price of shingles being lower than for some time a supply of 100000 shingles be purchased to be used in repairs to Municipal buildings.

The Treasurer recommended that only 50M shingles be purchased at this time. Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be adopted, subject to price not exceeding \$2.50 per M."

The meeting then adjourned.
