

Thursday - December 29th, 1938

A sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Thursday, December 29th, 1938 at 12.15 p.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton, D. Maxwell, H.S. Jebouit, J.G. Mill, and C.E. Brown.

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider Burnaby Trades License By-law 1938."

Ordered: "That the committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Trades License By-law 1938 be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Trades License By-law 1938 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The Engineer submitted recommendation that B.C.E.R. pole plank K.8800/2333 covering proposed pole location on Griffiths Avenue south of Beresford Street be approved, poles to be distant from the property line to the outside face of pole 10'6".

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Engineer be adopted."

The sitting then adjourned.
