

Wednesday - December 7th 1938.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, on Wednesday, December 7th 1938 at 10:00 a.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton, Dr. Sager, Dr. Fraser, A. C. Bell, J. G. Mill, E. L. Rimmer, F. J. Russell and C. E. Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of November 30th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Messrs Grant & McDougall wrote re the petition written by F. Monk and others re the closing hours of Dry Goods stores.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and that the petitioners request be refused on account of insufficiency."

Secretary, Riverway East Parent Teachers Assn. wrote expressing their appreciation for interest shown and donation made to their third annual bazaar.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

Alexander Walker and others wrote requesting a B. C. Electric Bus Service on 29th Avenue to Boundary Road. According to the petition this would serve 417 people.

Ordered: "That the petition be received and passed on to the B. C. E. R. for their consideration and survey."
