Ordered: "That the recommendations of the Treasurer be and are hereby adopted."

The Engineer submitted recommendations that B. C. E. R. Pole plans be approved as follows:

1. K-8800/2635 Proposed pole locations on Richmond Street east of Colbourne Ave. Distance from property to the outside face of poles to be 10'6".
- K-8800/2636 Proposed pole location on Burns Street east of Waltham Avenue. Distance from property line to the outside face of poles to be 10'6".

Ordered: "That the recommendations of the Engineer be adopted."

2. The Engineer submitted recommendation that B. C. Telephone Co. Pole Plan B-13728 covering proposed pole locations in the lane north of Union Street from Carleton Avenue to Willington Avenue, be approved. Distance from property line to the outside face of poles to be 1'6".

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Engineer be adopted."

The Relief Officer reported that all heads of families and single adults in receipt of relief, who have received relief through his department for the month of September, had produced proof of having registered under the National War Registration scheme.

The Relief Officer submitted report for the month of August showing total of 2600 persons in receipt of relief at a total cost of \$20,297.80.

Ordered: "That Burnaby Percentage Rebate By-law 1940/41 be introduced and read a first time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Percentage Rebate By-law 1940/41 do pass the first reading."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Percentage Rebate By-law 1940/41 be now read a second time."

Ordered: "That Burnaby Percentage Rebate By-law 1940/41 do pass the second reading."
