

Wednesday - June 19th 1940

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held in the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Wednesday, June 19th 1940 at 10:15 a.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton, C. B. Brown, A. McFee, Dr. Sager, Dr. Fraser, A. C. Bell, F. J. Russell and E. L. Rimmer.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of June 12th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Messrs H.H. Stewart, Pres. N.E. Board of Trade, G.A. Morrison and T. Bridges attended and addressed the Commissioner on the following matters:

- (1) Matter of rate in Fire Area No.1. as compared with rate in Fire Area No.2.

The Treasurer explained the respective set ups in the two areas and explained the reason for the difference in rate, and suggested that a Committee of the Board of Trade consider the question of petitioning the Corporation to create a fire area covering the entire Municipality.

- (2) Garbage collection in Business area Hastings St.
- (3) Light standard opposite the Regent Garage. The Building Inspector advised that this matter was receiving attention.

- (4) Matter of parking on the North side of Hastings St. in the Business section. The Clerk advised that this was a matter coming entirely under the control of the Public Works Department, but also advised that a committee was at present considering the matter of prohibiting parking at points within the jurisdiction of the Corporation.
- (5) Painting of guide lines at the intersection of Boundary Road and Hastings St. East. The Engineer advised that he would take this matter up with the Department of Public works and the City Engineer of Vancouver.

The Commissioner thanked the delegation for the clear and courteous manner in which they had presented the various matters.

The meeting then adjourned.
