

Wednesday - March 20th 1940

A regular sitting of the Acting Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Wednesday, March 20th 1940 at 10:00 a.m.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of March 13th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

A petition showing the names of 15 barbers was submitted asking for a change in the closing hour for barbers on certain days in the week.

Ordered: "That the petition be received and referred to the Clerk for report and recommendation."

The Treasurer submitted statement of receipts and payments for February, showing total receipts as \$83,016.41 and payments as \$91,739.87.

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

The Finance Committee submitted Estimates for the year 1940 and recommended that they be approved.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Finance Committee be adopted."

The Treasurer submitted Water Works return for the month of February showing 8002 live services as at February 29th. Collections totalled \$14,722.41.

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

The Relief Officer submitted report for the month of February showing total of 4143 persons in receipt of relief for the month, total expenditures was \$33,237.88.

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

The meeting then adjourned.
