

Friday 21st. June. 1940.

A special sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Friday, June 21st. 1940 at 11.20 a.m.

Present: Cmr. Fraser, R. Bolton, and C.B. Brown.

2. Dugald Donaghy wrote requesting authority to serve notice upon Mike Deliko to cease using Block 14, D.L. 213, as a means of ingress and egress to five squatters shacks on the foreshore of Burrard Inlet opposite said Block 14.

Ordered: "That the Notice to Mike Deliko be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That Mr. Dugald Donaghy be authorised for and in the name of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby and the Kapoor Sawmills Ltd. to apply for injunction prohibiting the use of Block 14, D.L. 213, as a means of ingress and egress to buildings situate on the foreshore of Burrard Inlet opposite said Block 14, in event of failure of the said Mike Deliko to observe the notice served upon him in this connection, subject to all expenses in connection therewith being borne by the Kapoor Sawmills Ltd."

Ordered: "That application for appointment of F. J. Copland as Commissioner for taking Affidavits within B.C. during such time as he is employed by the Corporation of the District of Burnaby be made to the proper authorities."

The sitting then adjourned.
