

Wednesday - May 28th 1941

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Wednesday, May 28th 1941 at 10:00 a.m.

Present: A/C. R. Bolton, F. J. Russell, A. McFee, Dr. Sager, Dr. Fraser, J. G. Mill, A. C. Bell, E. L. Rimmer and C. B. Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of May 21st inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

A petition containing a list of 691 names was read requesting better transportation facilities between the Capitol Hill district and the City of Vancouver.

Ordered: "That the petition be received and endorsed and that a meeting be arranged between the Commissioner and Mr. Murrin of the B. C. Electric Railway Co."

A delegation headed by Mr. Fleming, attended re transportation to the Lochdale area, claiming to represent 1400 persons. Mr. Fleming requested the services of the Municipal lawyer to present his case and asked for a letter endorsing his request. The Acting Commissioner advised the delegation he would require a petition to be submitted for his perusal, and that as far as the request for services of the Municipal lawyer was concerned, he would be prepared to favourably consider.

The requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That the requisitions as submitted be approved."

The meeting then adjourned.
