

Wednesday, July 30th, 1941.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, July 30th, 1941, at 10:00 a.m.

Present: A/C R. Bolton, F. J. Russell, Dr. Fraser, W.P. Philps, A.C. Bel J. G. Mill, E. L. Rimmer, and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the meeting of July 23rd, 1941 be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Burnaby Civic Employees Union - Burnaby Fire Fighters Association requesting payment of "cost of living bonus." The Acting-Commissioner pointed out that retroactive to January 1st, 1941, salary and wage increases amounting to from 4.16% to 12.50% had been granted in case of Municipal employees and from 12% to 21% in the case of Firemen and that these increases had brought wages up to the approximate level of 1926 to 1929. As the Dominion Order in Council provides for granting of a cost of living bonus when cost of living increases by 5% since the time of the last re-adjustment of wages and that whereas the cost of living has not increased by 5% since the date of the last adjustment he cannot see his way to granting any bonus at the present time.

Ordered: "That the letters be received and filed and that the Civic Employees Union and Fire Fighters Association be advised accordingly."


The requisitions were then examined.
