Errata:

C.M.C. Coquitlam Municipality wrote requesting that steps be taken to establish a thirty mile per hour speed zone on North Road.

The Clerk reported that Section 58 of the Motor Vehicle Act provides that a speed zone may be established by the Department of Public Works Engineer posting notice limiting speed upon request of the Commissioner of B.C. Police or upon request of Municipal Authorities with approval of the Commissioner of the B.C. Police.

RESOLVED: "That the Commissioner of B.C. Police be requested to approve of the establishment of a thirty mile per nour speed zone on North Road, from Clark Road to 10th Avenue (City Limits - New Westminster)".
