The City Clerk, Toronto, submitted copy of a resolution adopted by the City of Toronto, as follows:

RESOLVED: "Whereas the struggle for security against aggression from without should be accompanied by a search for security within; now therefore be it recommended that Council do petition the Dominion Government to establish in collaboration with the Provincial Governments, a Royal Commission, or other body, to examine and report on ways and means whereby, so far as may be, security from fear and want may justly and fairly be established for every man, woman and child in Canada; and that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Government of each Province and each Municipality in Canada, with a request that they memorialize the Federal and Provincial Governments to the same effect."
