

Wednesday - July 22nd, 1942.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, July 22nd at 10:00 a.m.

Present: A/C R. Bolton, J. Davidson, F. J. Russell, W. P. Philips, Dr. Sager, A. C. Bell, E. L. Rimmer and C. B. Brown.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the previous meeting be adopted as written and confirmed."

H.G. Perry, Chairman, Post-War Rehabilitation Council wrote advising that a public hearing has been arranged to take place in the City Hall New Westminster on the afternoon of August 4th. and that the Council will be pleased to receive such written suggestions as may be submitted.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and that a committee of the Engineer, Relief Officer and Clerk be appointed to consider data for submission with a request that they take under consideration the following: viz

(1) Matter of Public Utilities being placed underground.

(2) Suggested Municipal works which could be undertaken having in mind future maintenance of such works as may be constructed or carried out under the plan."

E. G. Baynes wrote offering his thanks and cooperation and Mr. A. S. Wooten, Supt. of Park Commissioners also wrote expressing his thanks and willingness to cooperate in the development of Barnett Mountain.


