Meved by Cr. Philps, Seconded by Cr. Beamigh: "That the Committee de new rise and report the By-law complete as amended. Carried Unanimously

Meved by Cr. Philps, Seconded by Cr. Gartlan: That Burnaby Tewn Planning By-law 1948, Amendment By-law Ne. 2, 1949 be new passed as amended. Carried Unanimously
