

Monday - December 5th 1949

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, Eimonds on Monday, December 5th 1949 at 9:45 A.M.

Present: Reeve Morrison in the Chair, Crs. Philps, Beamish, MacSorley, Gartlan, Stephens and Drummond.

Moved by Cr. Philps, Seconded by Cr. Beamish: "That the Council resolve into a Committee of the Whole with the Reeve in the Chair to consider Burnaby Town Planning By-law 1948, Amendment By-law No. 3, 1949."  
Carried Unanimously

C. Barber et al petitioned giving notice of protest of the proposed amendment to the Town Planning By-law to create a Commercial zone on the Douglas-Grandview Highway between Burriss and Nursery Streets, on the north side of the said highway.

G.N.Stowe et al submitted a petition protesting the proposed amendment to the Town Planning By-law to establish a Commercial zone on the north side of the Douglas-Grandview Highway between Burriss and Nursery Streets.

J.C.Ralston attended and spoke on behalf of the residents in the vicinity of Burriss Street and Grandview-Douglas-Highway protesting the establishment of the Commercial zone in the vicinity of Burriss Street and Grandview Highway, on the grounds that such zone would invite the erection of "shack" buildings which would be used for commercial purposes, and further that the said zone would create a traffic hazard due to its location at the foot of a long hill, and being located near the intersection of two important thoroughfares (Burriss & Grandview Highway.)

Moved by Cr. Philps, Seconded by Cr. Beamish: "That Section 22 as set forth under Section 1, Sub-section (a) of Burnaby Town Planning By-law 1948, Amendment By-law No. 3, 1949, be deleted from the said By-law."

Moved by Cr. Philips, Seconded by Cr. Gartlan: "That Burnaby Tax Sale Land's Monies Expenditure By-law No. 19, 1949 be now finally adopted, that it be signed by the Reeve and Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."
