An adjourned meeting of the Municipal Council was held at the Municipal Hall, 1930 Kingsway, onMonday, October 25, 1954 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: Reeve MacSorley in the Chair; Crs. W.P. Philps, Wilks, charlton, Hughes, Hean, F. Philps and Merrison,

E.Trotter wrote requesting an interview with the Council in connection with offers presented by the B.C. Electric Railway co. to property owners affected by the propesed spur line into the Safeway development in D.L.53.

Mr.Trotter appeared.

Meved by Cr. W.P. Philps, seconded by Cr. Wilks "That the spekesman be heard." Carried Unanimously.

Mr. Tretter spake protesting the actions of the B.C.E.R. in suBmitting offers to the residents in the area, the said effers being based on acceptance by all preperty owners affected of either the cutright purchase by the Company of the preperties or acceptance of a depreciative valuation by all concerned.

Mr. Tretter also criticized the appraiser hired by the B.C.E.R. Mrs. Os erne, Mr. French, Mr. Maxfield and Mr. Simpson owners of the property affected also spake expressing dissatisfaction of the effers made. Meved by Cr. W.P.Philps, seconded by Cr. Wilks "That the delegation be thanked and the Company be advised of the Council's dissatisfaction with the effers made to the ratepayers in that they were centrary to the understanding given the Council previously by the Company." Carried Unanimously.

Your Committee met on Tuesday, October 12, 1954 and recommend:

The new scale should be as fellews: \$357, 374, 392, 410 428 per month

Plumbing Inspector I
Same as Electrical Inspector I above.

Realty Appraisers
The new scale should be as fellows:

Realty Appraiser 1: \$312, 327, 342, 357, 374 (5 steps) Realty Appraiser 11: 342, 357, 374, 392m 480 (5 steps) per month.

Stores Division - Storemen and Storekeepers (Engineering Department) Steremen 1 - abelish the present 5 pay steps and establish one rate at \$238,00 per month

Storemen 2: (to be established). The Board agrees with the Empleyer's suggestion of establishing this position, which would carry, in addition to the elementary work of a storeman 1, the responsibility of supervising storeman 1 and labourers in the stores yard, the pay rate to be \$260,00 per menth.

The present scale is \$208, 218, 228, 238, 249 per menth. Clerk 2: The evidence before the Board indicated that the person filling this position was and is doing work of a higher level then that of maintaining clerical records. The Board, therefore, recommends that the holder of the Clerk 2 position be paid at the rate of \$260.00 per month from and including the 17th day of May 1954 until the appointment of Stereman 2 above. The Board also recommends

a new jeb classification survey of the work of the Stores Division The Board recommends that; for established positions, all increases be retreactive to January 1, 1954.
