A. C. Digney spoke requesting that the Council consider his application to conduct skeet shooting competitions at his Speedway property on MacPherson

Avenue.

Mr. Digney appeared and elaborated on his application, requesting that favourable consideration be granted, and advising that it was his intention to operate during day light hours and that no shooting competition would take place on Sundays. Moved by Cr. Hughes, seconded by Cr. W.P.Philps "That the application be re-ceived and referred to a Committee for investigation and report."

The Municipal Solicitor wrote relative to the proposed appeal By the Council to the Public Utilities Commission decision to allow fore increases on the B.C.E. Transit system, advising that in his opinion the Corporation should make a formal appeal. The Solicitor su mitted seven reasons on which he based his grounds for an appeal.

Moved by cr. F.Philps, seconded by Cr. Wilks "That a formal appeal against the decision of the Public Utilities Commission be entered by this Council in co-operation with the Municipality of North Vancouver district, North Vancouver City and the Municipality of Richmond, "

Carried Unanimously. City Clerk, City of Vancouver wrote advising of the endorsation of the said Council of this Council's application to the postal authorities in Ottawa for creation of a metropolitan postal system, and advising that the necessary letter in support had been forwarded to Ottawa. Moved by Cr. Morrison, seconded by Cr. W.P.Philps "That the letter be received."

Carried Unanimously.

The Special committee appointed to consider the request of Swanney ConcreteLimited for execution of a form of Consent required by the Resser Overseas Corporation in connection with the placement of a substantial piece of Machinery on property of the Swanney Concrete ompany submitted a recommendation that an acknowledgment Agreement prepared by the Mun-icipal Solicitor between the Corporation and the Besser Overseas Corporation be approved, and that authority be granted to execute same.
