(3) Application of Victor Leckerby to purchase Lets A to K inclusive, S.J.18 Blk. 2 J.L.25W, situated on the south side of a lane allewance south of 16th Avenue.

This preperty has no frentage at the present time on any read allegance but is included in the Glenbreck Seger Area Ne.3. system, upon completion of which a read allegance for 13th Avenue may be established upon which this preperty will front.

Your Committee would recommend that the above mentioned property be not sold until such time as the road allowance and sower line are installed.

(4) Application of G.S.Johnson to purchase Let 7, S.J.1, and Let 6, S.J.2 in Blk.2 J.L.39E2

The Engineer reported this Let 7 is situated on the south side of Forest Street 264 east of MacJonald Avenue and Let 6 is on the south side of Spruce Street 198 east of MacJonald Avenue. Assessed value - Let 7 \$450.00 and Let 6 \$525.00.

The Engineer reported that the above property contains a water course and has recommended that same be retained by the Corporation for drainage purposes. Your Committee recommend that the property be not sold.

Counciller Hughes submitted a statement addressed to the Vancouver Sun which he felt would not jeepardize the relationships existing and would provide a more progressive picture to the publishers and would establish a liaison between the publishers and the Corporation.
