Edmends Branch No. 10, Senier Citizens Asseciation of B. C. wrote suggesting that the Council consider some medium of traffic protection along Edmonds Street for elderly people residing in the New Vista development. The Association drew attention to the fatal accident which occurred recently and suggested that consideration be given to improved lighting along this Highway as well as a lighted crosswalk and traffic signal light,
