

Monday, July 9, 1956.

An adjourned meeting of the Municipal Council was held in the Council Chambers, 4000 Grandview Highway, on Monday, July 9, 1956 at 9.15 a.m.

Present: Reeve MacSorley in the Chair; Councillor W.P.Philps, Charlton, Drummond, Hughes, Hean, F.Philps and Morrison.

Greater Vancouver Water District extended an invitation to His Worship the Reeve and Council to inspect the Seymour Falls Intake and Cleveland Dam on Friday, July 13th at 10.00 a.m.

Ladner wrote with reference to the recent rezoning of the property - 0.314 acre portion of Lot 13, Blocks 9 and 10, J.L.SUN, advising that at the request of the Burnaby Ratepayers and Citizens' Association he was moving to quash the by-law effecting this rezoning and requesting that he be given an opportunity to discuss the matter prior to the filing of the By-law with the Country Court Registrar.
