Re: Burnaby Birthday Week Celebrations - 1965

At a meeting of the Burnaby Birthday Week Co-ordinating Committee on Thursday, May 27, 1965, a resolution was passed that the Committee incorporate as a Society under the Society's Act. This decision was made as a result of advice given by Council in response to a report which had been submitted by this Committee on May 25th.

The Municipal Solicitor has received copies of the Constitution and has taken in hand the registration formalities.

It is understood that, as an Incorporated Society, it is now necessary to apply for a "grant" instead of the usual budget allowance for the Burnaby Birthday Week celebrations.

The Burnaby Birthday Week Co-ordinating Committee would therefore request that Council consider this application for a grant in the amount of \$3,700.00 to finance the activities of the 1965 Birthday celebrations. The amount requested is made up as follows:
