RE: COMMUNITY PLAN FOR THE AREA EXTENDING FROM GAGLARDI WAY EASTWARDS TO STONEY CREEK RAVINE - LAKE CITY EAST

On December 15, 1969, Council considered a proposal for a compre-ensive housing development in the area bounded by Lougheed Highway, the Lake City spur track, Gaglardi Way, the proposed Como Lake Road extension and the proposed park-school site adjacent to Stoney Creek. (See maps #1 and #2)

Council at that time agreed in principle to the proposed development and authorized the Planning Department ... work with the developer in the preparation of a suitable plan of development reflecting the objectives and criteria established for this area and discussed in

the Planning Department report of December 11, 1969.

Work on the plans has now progressed to the point that a

Community Plan should be established for the area in order to permit
the start of a staged development and to ensure that the overall concept approved by Council in principle will be carried through to completion. Rezoning to CD Comprehensive Development should take place on a step-by-step basis, to implement the various stages of development, as set out in the Community Plan. In this latter respect, the developer has submitted a rezoning application covering the first stage of the development.

Elaboration of the plans has resulted in some changes which are considered within the terms of the original concept with the following exception: In the original concept the scuthern portion of the site adjacent to Lougheed Highway was proposed as a "Young People's Community". This area is now proposed as a townhouse development scheme under the auspices of the Federal Government. The program is of an experimental nature, its main objective being the provision of home ownership for lower income families.

The developer has now to meet certain commitments and has requested Council approval of a time schedule covering consideration of their proposal. Under this scedule a detailed Planning Department report covering the Community Plan and the related rezoning would be presented to Council on July 27, 1970, at which time if Council is satisfied with the proposal, it could be forwarded to a Public Hearing which they request be held on August 10 or August 11, 1970.

It is therefore recommended that Council adopt the following schedule for dealing with this Community Plan and its related rezoning:

Monday, July 27, 1970

presentation of detailed report to Council and establishment of a Public Hearing date (August 10 or 11 1970)

Monday, August 10 or Tuesday, August 11, 1970


