

6. Re: Chevron Canada Limited
Modernization Plan
Preliminary Plan Approval #1435
(Item 3, Report No. 65, October 12, 1971).

At the October 12, 1971, Council Meeting the following recommendation was approved regarding the above:

"THAT this request be tabled until the November 1, 1971, Council Meeting; and
THAT PPA #1435 be extended until November 1, 1971, at which time the matter of a further extension be reviewed; and
THAT Chevron Canada Limited be asked to ensure that Council receives a firm statement of intention from the Company with respect to the Carbon Monoxide Boiler on or before November 1, 1971; and
THAT Chevron's letter of October 5, 1971, and the contents of this report be forwarded to all parties that expressed an interest in this general subject when it was being debated."

Since this investigation is ongoing and will take more time to conclude before we are in a position to bring in a recommendation from staff, it is suggested that the matter of Chevron's request for an extension of PPA (as far as the segments which apply to the Rheniformer and to the Carbon Monoxide Boiler are concerned) until the three Council motions passed on July 12, 1971 have been resolved, be tabled for not more than a further two weeks.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the Chevron request to extend PPA #1435 as far as the Rheniformer and the Carbon Monoxide Boiler are concerned, until the three motions of Council passed on July 12, 1971 are resolved, be tabled for not more than a further two weeks; and
THAT the contents of this report be forwarded to Chevron and to all parties that expressed an interest in this general subject when it was being debated.
