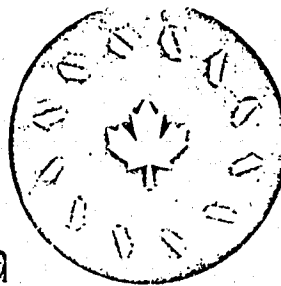


3. Re: Canada Summer Games
