1. Re: Christmas Bonus - Social Assistance.
(Item 7, Report No. 71, November 8, 1971)

When the above Item was discussed, a question was raised as to how much the granting of Christmas Bonuses cost the Municipality.

The Social Services Administrator advises that the approximate disbursement will be \$20,000, and our share is 15%, or \$3,000.

The cost to the Municipality of this Bonus in previous years is as follows:

1968	--	our share	\$2,070.
1969	--	our share	2,600.
1970	--	our share	2,700.
