9. Re: Sidewalk Crossings
(More particularly Loop Driveways)
(Item 19, Roport 68, October 25, 1971)
Mr. D. L. Passey of 4106 Gilpin Crescent appeared before Council on October 25 to appeal Council's decision to not grant him a second sidewalk crossing to serve his loop driveway.

The report item was tabled until November 8 th when a report was to be submitted indicating whether or not the Zoning Bylaw shoula be amended to allow for loop driveways, especially in cases where the loop driveway existed prior to the Zoning Bylaw being enacted in 1965.

It is the recommendation of the Planning Director and the Engineer that the Zoning By-law not be amonded for the reason that the stipulations and requirements would be most difficult to set out and enforce.

It is considered that a much more desirable way of achieving the same end would be through creation of a policy which would then be administered for each such crossing on its own merits, but without the somewhat stringent requirements which would be set out in a by-law amendment.

The Plamner and Engineer suggest that if the Council wishes to recognize the perpetuation of loop driveways that the following requirements be met in each case:

1. At least one of the "legs" of the loop driveway, at its point of intersection with the sidewalk crossing, must serve or have the ability to serve a legally conforming parking area.
2. Construction of the loop driveway must have preceeded the date when the new Zoning Bylaw was enacted in 1965.
3. The "straight" portion of the driveway, or in other words, that portion of the loop driveway which turnstangent and parallel to the road allowance, must be located entirely in private property, and not located partially on road allowance.
4. The "legs" of the loop driveway must be Jocated a reasonable distance away from lot corners, and not enter intersections closer than a stipulated number of feet, which normally for residential purposes would be approximately 5 feet from a cormer.

If Council accepts this policy statement, both Passey crossings would be automatienliy approved by the Engineer as an administrative mattor. The kngineer will sort out the paper work.

## RJCOMMENDATION:

THAT the four outilined rocuiromonts bo usod in dotorminjag whone such drivoways will bo pormittod to extst, but that thoso requipomonts bo administiosod onty as a polley of the monioipal Comedi; and
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
