REMARKS:

During the month an Inquest was held into the death of Reno YUNG, owner-operator of Teno Distributors Ltd., of 3910 Grant St., Burnaby, which occurred on June 18, 1971. The Coroner's Jury returned the verdict "homicide by person or persons unknown". As a result of evidence he gave at this Inquest, one of the Driver-Salesmen for Teno Distributors, Don Lee, has been charged with perjury and that case is before the courts.

Bruce William THORNHILL has been charged with the holdup of the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce at Old Orchard Shopping Centre and the \$611.00 loot has been recovered. Unfortunately, THORNHILL has since escaped from the custody of Vancouver City Police who were dealing with him on a Vancouver City offence. He is still at large and being sought across the country.

Several Social Welfare frauds were dealt with during September. One involved a woman who is charged with defrauding over \$3,000.00, and another Welfare fraud amounting to over \$1,200.00 involved a man. Both have been charged and the cases are before the courts.
