

26. Solid Waste Disposal --
Contract with Inter-Tidal Industries Ltd. (Terra Nova)
(Item No. 19, Manager's Report No. 37, Council Meeting
May 25, 1971)

At its meeting of May 25, 1971, the Municipal Council approved of the Corporation entering into a contract with Inter-Tidal (Terra Nova) for the disposal of solid wastes. The contract has not yet been executed.

The Company has now offered the Corporation the right to extend the term of the contract from May 15, 1973 to June 9, 1974, for a period of approximately 13 months, at the same negotiated price of \$2.50 per ton. All other terms and conditions are to remain the same. The new contract becomes effective November 16, 1971.

Such an extension will allow the company to have all its Municipal contracts end on the same date.

Inasmuch as the Engineer is unable to predict the likelihood of having available to the Corporation a method of refuse disposal which would result in a cost to the Municipality of less than \$2.50 per ton, he recommends that the contract have as its termination date June 9, 1974, rather than May 15, 1973, as previously approved by the Municipal Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT authority be granted to extend the contract
expiry date to June 9, 1974 under the same terms
and conditions; and
THAT the contract be with Inter-Tidal Industries Ltd.
