Dear Sir:

Re: Senior Citizens' Housing.

Considerable interest has been shown in developing senior citizen's housing projects in this Municipality. The large number of recent proposals has prompted the Council to direct this department to undertake research aimed at providing an assessment of the general need for this type of accommodation.

In order to properly evaluate the demand, a review of the current situation within the Lower Mainland Area is considered necessary. We would therefore request your assistance in providing us with information on this subject from your municipality as soon as possible, based on the following general outline:

- (1) The number of units (by type) available from existing projects, including both public and privately sponsored developments.
- (2) The number and type of units that will be provided by projects presently under development, and the estimated completion date for these projects.
- (3) Proposed projects (expected number and type of units and current status.)

Comments concerning the relationship between development and demand for senior citizens' housing in your area would also be appreciated. We would be pleased to provide you with the results of this survey once all the data have been compiled.
