25. Re: Proposed Local Improvement Project --  
Hazel Street from McKercher Avenue to McMurray Avenue.

We have reported separately on the Grange-Dover project, but in essence the Hazel Street project is a companion one to the Grange-Dover project. It is the remaining project previously approved for financing with Federal-Provincial Special Development Loan Funds.

Property acquisition is now complete on the subject portion of Hazel Street and it is now appropriate to proceed with the construction of same as a local improvement to a standard of 46 ft. curb to curb width road, including curb and gutter and 5½ ft. wide abutting sidewalks on both sides. The estimated cost of construction is now \$17,000, inclusive of an estimated cost for drainage of \$1,000. The amount included in the C.I.P. was \$12,000.

Ornamental street lighting under the normal policy of the Corporation to finance these works as a charge to the annual Capital Budget will be the only other municipal service required to be provided.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council authorize the initiation of this project as a local improvement.
